CHAMPAGNE

GOBBILARD, EPERNAY

Situated in the heart of Champagne, 5 km from Epernay, the magnificent village of Hautvillers dominates its vineyard. In about 1861, Dom Perignon, then cellar master in the benedictine abbey of Hautvillers, invented champagne as we know it today. It is thanks to this important event that Hautvillers became the most renowned village of the region.

The family champagne house cultivates about 25 hectares of vines, mostly in the Premier Cru vineyard of Hautvillers. Passion, dynamism and know-how characterise this growing family business, both in the vineyard and in commerce, with each stage carefully and rigorously controlled, while fully respecting the Champagne tradition.

BILLECART-SALMON, MAREUIL-SUR-AY

Small family-owned Grande Marque renowned for the consistently high quality of its rosé. The Blanc de Blancs is a rich, luscious with notes of almond, white fleshed fruit with a touch of vanilla. The celebrated rosé has great charm. The Nicolas François Billecart is a blend of Grand Cru Pinot and Chardonnay, a wine of fantastic intensity and depth of flavour, whilst the Cuvée Elisabeth is a delicate copper-coloured wine with aromatic notes of hazelnuts, hedgerow fruits and marzipan.

The house of Bollinger owns 150 ha of its own first class vines. The Special Cuvée has depth and complexity with half the wine fermented in oak barrels. The Vintage Grande Année, RD and the Vieilles Vignes Françaises (based on three small parcels of ungrafted Pinot Noir wines in Ay and Bouzy) are deep, powerful and serious wines.

Régis Camus makes creamy soft Champagnes of ample grain and texture. The Brut Réserve is wonderfully harmonious: aromas of violets, lilac and dried apricots. Brut Vintage reveals honey and nut on the nose, behind a layer of white fruits. Blanc des Millenaires has a lightly honeyed nose, aromas of polished wood and dried white fruits.

DEUTZ , Aÿ

Deutz is the epitome of understated excellence. Founded in 1838, the House is situated amongst the vineyards of one of the region's greatest villages: Aÿ-Champagne.

This sums up Deutz's approach, in which style is always matched by substance.

Champagne Deutz Brut Classic carefully blends the three champagne grapes to perfection; the freshness of the Chardonnay and the richness of the Pinot Noir enhance the wine's full-bodied elegance. A trio of prestige cuvées represent the pinnacle of the House's achievement in three styles: graceful Blanc de Blancs, compelling Pinot-dominated vintage, and rich, 100%-grand cru rosé.

DEVAUX, AUBE

'There is no great champagne without the right soil and location.'

Founded in 1846 by brothers Jules and Auguste Devaux and was entrusted to the Union Auboise 1987 as the House was without an heir. It owes its character to 3500 acres of vineyard situated in the heart of the Côte De Bar, which produces some of best Pinot Noir in all of Champagne.

DOM PÉRIGNON, EPERNAY

The life of the Benedictine Monk, brother Pierre, was dedicated to the improvement of wines within the Champagne region His preference was for red Grapes because the second fermentation was less likely and produced the style that was eventually to become so popular his wines were double the price of the Abbeys rivals. Although the Abbey ceased production in the French revolution. His name launched the first Cuvée prestige in 1937.

DRAPPIER, REIMS

*'Why do I drink Champagne for breakfast?

A favourite of Charles de Gaulle, Aube-based Drappier Champagnes are fruity, lively and exuberant. Carte d'Or Brut has the classic Pinot Noir aroma conveying subtle citrus and red fruits with yeasty bread. The vigorous Grand Sendrée is produced from vines planted over 70 years ago with 55% elegant Chardonnay and 45% Pinot Noir giving body and fruit.

DUVAL-LEROY, VERTUS

Based in Vertus, Côte de Blancs, Duval-Leroy is now one of the largest land-owners in all Champagne. The wines reflect this location, demonstrating a quality of Chardonnay not to be found elsewhere. The house style here is elegance, freshness, with good fruit.

GOSSET, AY

Established in 1584, Gosset is one of the oldest houses in the region, in 1992 becoming the first new Grande Marque for more than 30 years. Gosset fruit is sourced from the Premier and Grand Cru villages of the Marne region. Harvesting is manual with just the first pressings being used.

Founded in 1808, Henriot's belief is in careful grape selection and extended cellaring before release, bringing a richer style, often creamy on the palate. As the wines age yeasty bread like character appears.

KRUG, REIMS

'The feeling of friendship is like that of being comfortably filled with roast beef; love, like being enlivened with champagne.'

Krug is distinctive and easily recognized by taste due to complete barrel fermentation and extended lees aging; on the nose, Krug is identified by its strongly developed and aged nutty lees influence and a certain oakiness. On the palate, Krug wines commonly display a raciness derived from their unique production; suppression of the malolactic fermentation, richness both from lees and barrel fermentation.

LAURENT-PERRIER, TOUR SUR MARNE

Founded in 1812, Laurent Perrier has maintained family ownership, though the family name has changed through sale and bequeath. In 1945 army sergeant Bernard de Nonancourt broke into Hitler's wine cave in the Bavarian Alps, where he discovered half a million bottles of wine including a few hundred cases of Salon Champagne, which he had witnessed being stolen from his neighbour five years earlier. On return, Bernard started a 4-year apprenticeship within other houses in preparation to take over Laurent- Perrier from his mother with these guiding words: 'You'll never make a good Director without being a good worker'

LOUIS RŒDERER, REIMS

Brut Premier, aged about 3.5 years before release, is built on a core of Pinot Noir with 20% of Rœderer's wood-aged reserves. Cristal, an equal blend of Pinot and Chardonnay, is an iconic wine with considerable finesse combining the incision of a great Côtes des Blancs with the rich rounded fruit of the Montagne de Reims as well as complex aromas of honey and beeswax that denote ageing in wood.

POL ROGER, EPERNAY

'Remember gentlemen, it's not just France we are fighting for, it's Champagne!' Winston Churchill

Pol Roger, thanks to the enthusiastic endorsement of Winston Churchill, has always been regarded with fondness by the British people. The wines tend to be seductive with a plump, honey-tinged richness, yet quite shy on the finish. The vintage brut is composed of 60% Pinot Noir and 40% Chardonnay. The Rosé has a pale, onion skin hue, and a lovely nose, demonstrating a refined, mineral-infused quality.

RUINART, REIMS

Ruinart, established in 1729, is another laying claim to be the first Champagne house. A blend of 100% Premier Cru Chardonnay from different years it has a very beautiful pale golden yellow colour. An intense nose with notes of fresh citrus fruit, mainly lime, greets you followed by a very supple, round and harmonious palate. Dom Ruinart is



100% Grand Cru Chardonnay—a fine, fresh and delicate nose with a beautiful intensity. Notes of fresh almonds, toasted brioche, citrus fruits and dried fruits, fine

and delicate sensation on the palate and a finish suggestive of fresh citrus fruit notes and coffee.

VEUVE CLICQUOT PONSARDIN, REIMS

Champagne's greatest dame was Nicole-Barbe Clicquot – Ponsardin. Following the death of her husband in 1805 she was thrust at the age of 27 years old into a competitive and male dominated business. She became one of Champagnes greatest entrepreneurs and innovators making Veuve Clicquot into a Grande Marque. Always striving for perfection she was instrumental in developing the system of remuage for clarifying the wine.
